SATURDAY ITINERARIES

Saturday Itineraries will be plan throughout the day for a total of 8 hours, with variable shedule time which will depend on the destination.

Tourist-cultural itineraries will lead students to discover the Italian literary, artistic and cultural heritage through paths across the most fascinating places of Rome and the Castelli Romani. Thanks to strategic narratives conceived by "Tor Vergata" teachers and experts in Italian literature, art history, geography and territory, students will experience the emotion of discovering naturalistic and urban places by understanding their history behinds and their beauty through the words of the greatest Italian and foreign writers of the past and present. Through the most beautiful pages of Goldoni, Leopardi, Belli, Trilussa Pirandello, Deledda, Ungaretti, Scego, and also Goethe, Keats and Shelley among many others, students will visit Rome and Castelli Romani, enjoy artistic beauties of antiquity, Baroque squares, and contemporary Houses and exhibitions (Piazza Navona, Campo de'

Fiori, Colosseo, Casa Pirandello, Casa De Chirico, Villa Mondragone and other Tuscolane Villas). There will also be opportunities to understand the bond between this territory and its food and wine heritage through immersive experiences and many other surprises! The detailed programme, with scheduled days and times, will be available only after registration closes when classes of the required language level will be composed. Tourist-cultural itineraries will be distributed in the final calendar which will be structured differently according to each language level class.
