

Public call for applications for the admission to the CLICI Summer School a.y. 2025-2026

Period: July 13-25, 2026

Registration opening: February 25, 2026

Registration deadline: April 23, 2026

Art.1 – Object and Purpose

CLICI – Center for Italian language and culture – of Tor Vergata University of Rome issues a notice of public selection (a maximum number of 60 students are admitted) to enroll the CLICI Summer School a.y. 2025-2026 that will take place from July 13 to July 25, 2026. CLICI Summer School wants to enhance the knowledge of Italian language and culture to international students from all over the world by offering an intensive course that includes lessons of Italian language and tourist-cultural itineraries across the Region of Lazio, Metropolitan City of Rome Capital and Castelli Romani.

Art. 2 Programme

1 – CLICI Summer School programme includes the activities as follows:

Students will participate in 30 hours of Italian language lessons sheduled from Monday to Friday morning. Classes will be held by teachers designated by CLICI as qualified for teaching Italian as a foreign language. The employed teaching methodology places the student at the center of the learning process through interactive and entertaining activities aimed to engage students and encourage them to use the Italian language in different contexts (formal and informal). Lessons will be adapted to the students' language skill level and will also deal with topics connected to the tourist-cultural itineraries. Classes will be held in the CLICI's classrooms at 'CX Rome'.

Students will participate in 6 tourist-cultural itineraries to be attended in the afternoon (4 hours each) and 2 itineraries on Saturdays (8 hours each). Participants will be led to discover the natural and cultural heritage of the territory of Rome and its surroundings across Lazio.

The itineraries will be carried out by promoting aslow and sustainable tourism with the aim of providing immersive and interdisciplinary experiences. Participants will enjoy strategically constructed narratives which combine different topics relating to history, literature, artistic and performative productions, craftsmanship, food and wine traditions.

Art. 3 Requirements for participation and ranking list of admitted candidates

CLICI Summer School is open to candidate students having the age of majority (18 years old), and who follow the registration procedure correctly and on time. Admissions are subjected to a maximum number of available registrations: 60 places. The ranking list of admitted candidates will be formulated considering the activation of the classes of the language level indicated by candidates during the registration procedure. The chronological order in which the application form was submitted on the online system is the criteria on which the selection of candidates is based on. Publication of the ranking list serves as official communication to all candidates who have made application.

Art. 4 Admission procedure and payment of enrolment fee

Terms of registration open on February 25, 2026

Total cost for the CLICI Summer School:

- 800 € for external students not enrolled at Tor Vergata University of Rome
- 700 € for internal students (enrolled at any course of Tor Vergata University of Rome, or coming from affiliated universities)
- 650 € for students belonging to affiliated universities and who request a group registration (minimum 5 students)
- 0 € for political refugee students with documentation certifying their refugee status in Italy (for a limited number according to total number of enrolled students, and one in five ratio)

In order to participate in Full Programme, it is mandatory to complete the pre-enrollment application by **April 23, 2026** at the following link: <https://delphi.uniroma2.it/totem/jsp/corsiErogati/accedi.jsp> and to pay the pre-registration bill of 150 euros as an advance payment of the registration total cost. The pre-registration bill will be generated by the system after completing the pre-enrollment application.

Confirmation of the activation of the class of the Italian language level indicated by candidates during registration procedure, as well as demand to complete the registration procedure, will be provided to students by **April 28, 2026**. The class will be activated if the minimum number of candidates will be achieved.

Starting from April 29, 2026 another bill will generate by the system in order to complete the payment of **enrollment fee**:

- 650 € for external students not enrolled at Tor Vergata University of Rome
- 550 € for internal students (enrolled at any course of Tor Vergata University of Rome, or coming from affiliated universities)
- 500 € for students belonging to affiliated universities and who request a group registration (minimum 5 students)
- Students with documentation certifying their political refugee status in Italy will not have to pay any tax bill. When registering, the online system will require to upload the documentation certifying their refugee status

The bill to complete the payment of enrollment fee **must be paid by and no later than May 15, 2026.**

Pre-enrollment refund is reserved only in case the class of the required Italian language level will be not activated. Student who wants to be refunded can activate the procedure following the information which will be received by email.

Enrollment fee is non-refundable for any reason.

The total cost of the CLICI Summer School **does NOT include room and board**, which are entirely the student's responsibility. Art. 5 Confirmation of admission

Candidates will be contacted by CLICI at your email address indicated on the registration form. Winner candidates will have to complete the payment of the enrollment bill by **May 15, 2026**. Non-admitted candidates will be able to activate the refund procedure by following the information received by email.

Art.6 Scholarships

Within the project a selection is announced for the assignment of 3 scholarships for total exemption from any amount due for CLICI Summer School enrollment;

Requirements for admission to the selection

This selection is reserved for students with the following criteria:

- To be regularly enroll in any university course of study lasting no less than 2 years;
- To be NOT enroll at Tor Vergata University of Rome.

Submission of the application form

In order to submit your application, it is mandatory to fulfill the form at the following link: <https://forms.office.com/e/vzNgQMS7DY>

The application form must be completed in all its parts and includes personal data, Study Degree/qualification obtained, university career, average grade for each course of study, language skill level in English, language skill level in Italian, short motivational letter written in English or Italian.

The application form remains open until **March 23, 2026**.

The Examining Commission will evaluate the scholarship applications according to the following criteria:

- University career (max. 10 points)
- Language skill level in English (max. 5 points)
- Motivational letter (max. 15 points)

In order to define the ranking, the Examining Commission will evaluate the titles and the motivational letter. In the event of a tie, the youngest candidate takes precedence.

Selected candidates will receive an e-mail asking for the needed documentation to verify the veracity of what declared on the application form, by **April 10, 2026**. Requested documentation must be sent by **April 20, 2026**.

Examining Commission

The Examining Commission will be appointed by decree of the General Director of the University and will be composed of 3 members, selected from among professors, experts and TAB staff (technical, administrative, and librarian staff) for the verbalization.

Provisional ranking

Provisional ranking will be posted publicly on the CLICI website (<http://clici.uniroma2.it/clici-summer-school/>) by **April 10, 2026**. The first 8 students placed in the ranking will receive an e-mail asking for the needed documentation to verify the veracity of what declared on the application form. Requested documentation must be sent by and no later than **April 20, 2026**. In the event of unsuitable documentation, the Examining Commission will proceed with scrolling, in compliance with the ranking, to suitable candidates in a useful position.

Winner Ranking

The winner ranking will be made public by posting both on the CLICI website (<http://clici.uniroma2.it/clici-summer-school/>) and on the University web page (<http://web.uniroma2.it>) by **April 23, 2026**.

Students will receive communication about the activation of the class of the Italian language level (indicated by them during the registration procedure) by **April 28, 2026**.

Winner students must apply to CLICI Summer School by following the procedure as indicated in art. 4.

- Winners of total scholarships will have not to pay any fee. Please note that the full scholarship covers only the educational offer (value €800.00) and does not cover travel, board and lodging costs, which are the responsibility of the student.

Art. 7 Final Certificate

All participants who attend at least 70% of the hours scheduled for the activities (language lessons and tourist-cultural itineraries) will receive a certificate of attendance indicating the achieved level of Italian language.

Art. 8 Translation and controversies

In case of controversies relating to this Note, the Court of Rome is the competent authority. The Italian version of the document will prevail and not its translation.

Art. 9 – Information Privacy

The processing of personal data requested by this Notice is aimed exclusively at this selection procedure, in accordance with the provisions of EU Regulations no. 679/2016 of 27 April 2016 “General Data Protection Regulation” of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 (in hereinafter referred to as GDPR), to Legislative Decree 196/2003, as amended by Legislative Decree 101/2018, as well as in compliance with the provisions of the Guarantor for Data protection.
